MO TBF held its final event for 2011 at Stockton Lake. This was the final qualifying event of the year to fill out the State Championship Team for Divisionals in 2012. We had great weather for fishing but the catch was very tough. Temps were in the high 40's in the morning with some fog and in the upper 70's in the afternoon at weigh-in time.

This 2-day event did not yield the quantity of bass that some were looking for. Day one a total of 87 fish were caught and 82 fish were brought to the scales on day two. Jonathan Small provided big bass on day one weighing in at 6.20 lbs. Day two big bass was brought to the scales by Brian Maloney weighing 4.83 lbs. A total weight of 22.71 lbs took first place in the event and that was provided by Brian Maloney. Don Heiser took second place with a total weight of 19.97 lbs and third place was claimed by Brad Tyer with a total weight of 17.08 lbs.

Plaques were provided to the top eight places in the Championship tournament and 4 plaques were given to the top 4 anglers from the Series Opens. These 12 anglers plus one alternate will make up our State team and represent our Missouri TBF at the Central Divisionals in 2012.
